

104 POLICY - Policies and Procedures

104.1 Statement of Policy

As the governing body of Redlands Community College, the Board of Regents has full authority and responsibility for the College. The power to adopt policies, to select and appoint the President, to review and evaluate management, to act as an appeal tribunal and all other non-delegable powers and duties are specifically reserved to the Board of Regents.

The Board of Regents delegates management of the College to the President, who is charged with all executive functions. Procedures are the mechanisms established for the purpose of implementing Board policy and for internal administration of the institution. Adoption of procedures is an executive and administrative function within the authority delegated to the President.

104.2 Policies

Policies may be adopted, amended, modified, or repealed solely by action of the Board of Regents. The College President is charged with responsibility for making recommendations to the Board of Regents on all policy matters. All proposed policy matters must be submitted to the President for administrative review and recommendation prior to submission to the Board of Regents for action.

104.3 Procedures

Procedures that address internal management of the institution may be adopted, amended, modified, or repealed by College administration, subject to the President's approval, and Board action on such procedures shall not be required.
