615.1 Statement of Policy

Redlands Community College is certified to participate in the Title IV programs by qualifying as an eligible institution according to federal regulation. The criteria and procedures to be followed in implementing this policy are published in the Procedures section of the Policies and Procedures Manual.

615 PROCEDURE - Certification

615.1:1 Statement of Procedure

Redlands Community College is certified by the US Department of Education Federal Student Aid School Eligibility Channel.

Redlands Community College has been certified to participate in the Title IV program since the initial approval date of April 12, 1965. Being a public institution, Redlands Community College has undergone no changes in ownership.

615.1:2 Period of Participation

Redlands Community College has been fully certified to participate in the Title IV programs specified in the Program Participation Agreement. Redlands Community College will reapply for certification no later than 90 days prior to the end of certification for each academic year.

A copy of the ECAR and PPA are maintained in the office of the Director of Financial Aid for Redlands Community College.
